## Terms and Conditions

Cancellation of our services in the event of our services being cancelled, Lydd Air will make alternative travel arrangements with another carrier. This will normally involve a passenger ferry service between the U.K. and France. Transport to/from Lydd Airport and the ferry port will be provided by Lydd Air.

**Force Majeure.** Lydd Air shall not be liable for any failure to perform the contract which is due to unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond the control of Lydd Air or our suppliers, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised: including but not limited to war, threat of war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute including air traffic control disputes, terrorist activity, natural and nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions, technical problems with transport, closure or congestion of airports or ports.

**Cancellation of inclusive tour bookings.** Should it become necessary for the Customer to cancel their booking, the following cancellation charges will be applied:

More than 15 days prior to departure 25% of the total cost  
14 days prior to departure or less 50% of the total cost

Our Fly and Dine products operate subject to certain economic requirements. Should they prove inoperable, we will advise you at the first opportunity and offer alternative dates or arrangements. In the event of these not being suitable we will refund all monies paid.

**Passports and Visas.** All passengers leaving and entering the United Kingdom must be in possession of a valid passport which will be valid for at least six months after date of return to the U.K. Some non-E.U. nationals may also require an entry visa for France. Lydd Air will not accept for carriage any passenger who is not in possession of the correct documentation.

**Surcharges.** Lydd Air will make every effort to ensure that the price quoted will be the final price paid by the Customer. However, increases in fuel costs or taxes, significant fluctuations in exchange rates or increases in airport taxes will be passed on to the Customer. When a surcharge represents less than 2% of the total holiday cost, the increase will be absorbed by Lydd Air. When the increase represents more than 2% of the total holiday cost, the first 2% will be absorbed by Lydd Air, the remainder to be met by the Customer before outward travel.

**Brochure description.** The contents of these details were correct at time of going to press. Any significant change in circumstances will be notified at time of booking.

**Payments.** Payment in full is required at time of booking. Payment may be made by cheque or major credit/debit card.

**Unaccompanied Children.** Unaccompanied Children under the age of eight will not be accepted for carriage. Inclusive flight and hotel bookings will not be accepted for unaccompanied children under the age of sixteen.

**Complaints.** Should any part of this product fail to please, complaints must be put in writing to be received by Lydd Air no more than five days after the date of return to the U.K. Complaints regarding your hotel should, in the first instance, be registered with the Hotel Manager.

**Luggage Allowance.** Each passenger is permitted a total of 15kg of luggage, including hand luggage. Lydd Air reserves the right to refuse to carry any baggage that is considered abnormal in size or weight. Excess luggage is carried only if loads permits and is charged at £1 per kilo.

**Consumer Protection.** Passenger's interests in relation to any inclusive tour arrangements made by Lydd Air Ltd are protected by the formation of the Lydd Air Trust Fund, administered by Hallet & Co., Solicitors, 11 Bank Street, Ashford, Kent.

**In accordance with EU Council Regulation 2027/97 the following conditions apply:**

In the event of an accident, Lyddair's liability is not subject to any financial limit, be it defined by law, convention or contract in respect of damages sustained in the event of death, wounding or any other bodily injury by a passenger. Lyddair has strict liability for the first 100,000 SDRs (approximately £85,000) of any claim unless it can prove that the damage was caused by, or contributed to by, the negligence of the injured or deceased passenger. For claims in excess of this limit, Lyddair may be exonerated if it can prove that it and its agents took all necessary measures to avoid the damage or that it was impossible for it or them to take such measures. Lyddair will without delay, and in any event not later than 15 days after the identity of the natural person entitled to compensation has been established, make such advance payments as may be required to meet immediate economic needs on a basis proportional to the hardship suffered. Without prejudice to the above, an advance payment of at least 15,000 SDRs (approximately £13,000) per passenger will be made in the event of death. Making an advance payment shall not constitute recognition of liability and may be offset against any subsequent settlement. The payment shall be non-returnable unless Lyddair proves that the damage was caused by, or contributed to by, the negligence of the injured or deceased passenger; or where it is subsequently proved that the person who received the advance payment was not the person entitled to compensation; or it is subsequently proved that the person who received the advance payment caused, or contributed to, the damage by negligence. Lyddair has insurance cover of at least 100,000 SDR per passenger and no less than the minimum stipulated by the Civil Aviation Authority.

## Le Touquet – France's 'Paris Plage'

Today's visitors enjoy Le Touquet just as much. They like the shops and boutiques, gourmet restaurants, seafront cafés, art galleries, oyster bars, casinos, golf courses, gardens, racecourse and street markets. They like the feel of the place, which manages to be sophisticated, charming, lively, refreshing and relaxing all at the same time. This mix has turned Le Touquet into one of France's top exhibition and conference venues. Many events take place at the Palais de l'Europe, which combines 1930's style with the latest facilities.

Le Touquet is delightfully compact, so it's easy to walk around. Strollers can call in at a pavement café, order a coffee, beer or glass of wine, and watch the world go by. The town's wide, sandy beach is never far away, and it doesn't take much longer to reach the vast, empty beaches and sand-dunes to the south.

Sports and activities in Le Touquet include horse riding, sand yachting, tennis, archery, pétanque, sailing, cycling and fishing. Your children will love Aqualud water park and its exciting water slides.

Le Touquet is a great touring base for exploring Nord-Pas de Calais, Picardie, Normandie and Northern France in general. Historic centres such as Amiens and Arras are within easy reach. Not far from the fast autoroutes are the grand chateaux, tree-lined roads, quaint villages and the sleepy provincial France that everyone hopes to find.

## Lydd International – fast track to France

Easy to get to, easy to use and remarkably efficient, Lydd International Airport is how every airport should be. There's no congestion, no waiting, no hassle, no fuss – it really is as good as this. Lydd Airport is situated 22km (14 miles) south of Ashford in Kent, halfway between the south coast towns of Dover and Hastings. It overlooks the sea and has a good weather and flight reliability record.

After exiting the M20 motorway at Junction 10 and joining the A2070 Southbound, the airport is well signposted. The motorway-to-terminal journey time is only 20 minutes, whether it's the morning peak, evening peak or, indeed, any time of day! London to Lydd Airport takes as little as 1 hour 20 minutes by car and about the same time by train and taxi.

The principal scheduled service from Lydd is the daily peak-season service (reduced service off-season) to Le Touquet in northern France. Lydd Air operates this popular service using three-engined, 16-seat Britten-Norman Trislanders.

There's plenty of free parking at Lydd Airport – helping to make day-trip flights even more affordable – and overnight parking is only £3.

## Try the Fly'N'Train to Paris!

Have you thought about using Lydd Air to Le Touquet followed by the train to Paris? Flights to Le Touquet connect with fast trains linking Étapes-Le Touquet with Paris Gare du Nord city centre station. The rail journey takes 2 hours and 20 minutes and the fare is €25.60 one way – making the Fly'N'Train a quick and cost effective solution.

## Fly to France from your local Connex station

Lydd Airport is 20 minutes by taxi from Ashford International, Kent's major interchange station where local and regional Connex and international Eurostar services meet. From Ashford, trains run every 15 minutes or so to/from London Waterloo, Victoria and Charing Cross, with the fastest trains taking just over an hour.

Rye station is on the Ashford-Hastings line and is 15 minutes from Lydd Airport. Taxi transfers from Ashford and Rye start at £15 each way. Buses link Lydd Airport with New Romney and Hythe to the east, and Rye, Hastings, Eastbourne and Brighton to the west.
